A Supreme Championship will not be awarded to animals retrospectively, but an animal will be eligible to be awarded the title of Supreme Champion, if they gain some points towards the title of Supreme Champion (1000 points) after the implementation date of 1 July 2012.

If the dog does not currently hold the title of Grand Champion, proof of 1000 points must be supplied.
