

Dogs Victoria Breeder Series Agreement to Provide Veterinary Services

Dogs Victoria Regulation 20.8.4 states that a breeder shall have a written agreement with one or more veterinary practitioners that describes arrangements for veterinary care of their animals. You may choose to use this template to meet this requirement, or your veterinarian may have their own agreement document.
