

CAMP SITE GUIDELINES

Bookings & payment must be made through the Dogs Victoria Office prior to your arrival date. events@dogsvictoria.org.au / 03 9788 2500

- Camping must be PRE-BOOKED through the Office prior to arriving onsite at Bulla or KCC Park for camping. A camping form must be completed and sent to the office, and a return email received confirming your camping has been approved for your requested dates.
- Only self-contained mobile homes, RV's or caravans are permitted for use when camping onsite. 'Self-contained' refers to having in built shower/toilet facilities and supplying your own power source. Powered sites are not available at either venue.
- There is no access to electricity for camping, no access to shower facilities and no access for waste disposal onsite at either venue this needs to be taken into consideration when you are thinking about camping onsite.
- Public toilets are available onsite during event times, though these are not available outside of event times
 and office hours which is why you need to have your own self-contained vehicle.
- The following is NOT PERMITTED;
 - Camping in tents or swags
 - Sleeping in your vehicle if it is not a self-contained mobile home, RV or caravan as stated above
 - Setting up portable showers or toilets outside

Camp sites are restricted to the designated camping areas ONLY. Members are not permitted to set up camping elsewhere at the venue and will be asked to move to a designated camping area if they have set up in the incorrect spot. Refer to the below maps for permitted camping areas.

Dogs Victoria Staff & Facilities Committees will check for your confirmation of camping onsite. You will need to show your confirmation email received from the office. If you do not have this confirmation, email you will need to provide your name and member number and the office will contact you the next business day for payment.

Dogs Victoria Staff & Facilities Committees have the right to ask you to move if you are not set up in a designated camping area.

Dogs Victoria Staff & Facilities Committees have the right to ask you to leave if you do not have the correct camping set up as stated above.

Dogs Victoria Staff & Facilities Committees will not accept any rude or aggressive behaviour and have the right to ask you to leave if they deem your behaviour to be inappropriate.

Camping bookings are non-refundable

Only members of Dogs Australia state bodies are permitted to camp onsite

Dogs Victoria reserves the right to decline camping requests if the site is booked out

It is the members responsibility to be aware of the camping policy prior to arriving onsite. It is not Dogs Victoria's responsibility to find alternate accommodation if the above policy is not adhered to.


Signing the camp site booking form confirms you have read and agreed to all the above.
