

Dogs Victoria Camping Policy

Camping bookings must be pre booked through the online system prior to your arrival date.

Camp site bookings must be made online via Show Manager

- Go to the Camping Sites on the left-hand side.
- Select the venue you wish to camp at – KCC Park or Bulla Exhibition Centre.
- Camp sites will be open 2 days before and after events are taking place. Select your dates and follow the prompts to fill out your details and pay online. You will receive an email confirmation from Show Manager confirming your booking and you must display this in your vehicle window when you are onsite.

Only self contained motorhomes, RV's or caravans are permitted for use when camping onsite. 'Self contained' refers to having in built shower & toilet facilities and supplying your own power source.

Dump sites are not available at Dogs Victoria grounds and there are no powered camping sites available at Dogs Victoria grounds. This needs to be considered before booking camping.

Public toilets are available onsite during event times, however these are not intended for use after hours which is why you are required to have your own self contained vehicle.

The following is NOT permitted:

- Camping in a tent or swag
- Sleeping in your vehicle if it is not a self contained motorhome, RV or caravan
- Setting up of portable showers or toilets outside
- Generators **not** to be used between 9PM - 7AM

Camping is restricted to designated camping sites ONLY.

Members are not permitted to set up camping elsewhere on the property.

When you make your camping booking online you will be allocated a numbered site and this is where you must camp.

Please note the following:

Check in after 3pm on the first day of booking

Check out by 2pm on the last day of booking

A copy of your camping confirmation booking MUST BE DISPLAYED IN YOUR VEHICLE WINDOW WHILE YOU ARE ONSITE. Dogs Victoria Staff/Event Representatives and Facilities Committee will be onsite checking off camping bookings on event days.

Dogs Victoria Representatives have the right to ask you to move if you are not set up in your allocated camping site.

Dogs Victoria Representatives have the right to ask you to leave the premises if you do not have the correct camping set up or required booking confirmation.

Dogs Victoria has a zero tolerance for rude and aggressive behaviour and anyone not adhering to the policy will be asked to leave. Repeat offences of not adhering to the camping policy or treating Dogs Victoria representatives disrespectfully can result in being banned from camping on the grounds.

Camping bookings are non-refundable.

Camping is only available to members of Dogs Australia state bodies.

If sites are fully booked Dogs Victoria has the right to decline camping bookings.

It is the members responsibility to be fully aware of the camping policy and by submitting an online booking you are agreeing to all of the points outlined in the camping policy.

KCC Park Gate Instructions

The front gate at KCC Park automatically opens at 6am and closes at 10pm at night. Please take this into consideration when making your travel plans.

If you are in the venue after 10pm, you can exit by driving up to the gate and a sensor will open it for you. After 10pm the gate will not open if you are trying to re-enter the venue after 10pm.

Bulla Exhibition Centre Gate Instructions

To enter the venue – On the right hand side of the gate on the wall is a keypad. Enter code to open the gate & drive through. Once entered, re enter the code on the keypad on the right hand side to close the gate behind you if after hours.

To exit the venue – Drive up to the yellow lines marked on the driveway, a sensor will automatically open the gate for you to drive through and it will close automatically behind you.
